Progress is well advanced in cutting back tree braches emanating from the islands that are touching the water surface. This will contribute to reducing the number terminal "Break offs" and the demand for water during drought conditions. This summer saw a period in excess of 13 weeks without rain though fortunately water levels never became unacceptably low.

During mid month both the Mixed and Carp lakes had several smaller fish removed in order the food source contributes more to growth of the remaining fish. In addition the winter daily fish feeding programme commenced.
