This is particularly important when fishing at night and all anglers wishing to fish at Manor Fisheries during 2011 are required to become a Night Fishing Member. This can be achieved by downloading (or requesting) an **Application Form via the PRICES tab** and returning a completed Form per angler to Manor Fisheries.
